Newborn puppies receive some temporary immunity to disease through antibodies absorbed through their mother's milk. After weaning, this natural immunity begins to disappear. It is at this time, that puppies should begin a health-care program that includes a series of vaccinations. Most common infectious diseases can be prevented by routine vaccination and periodic physical examinations. Among the diseases that all dogs should be protected against by vaccinations are:
